STORM DEBRIS:

- PLACE **VEGETATIVE DEBRIS** ON THE RIGHT OF WAY (NOT IN DITCH)
- DO NOT BLOCK ROADS OR POWERLINES WITH PILES OF DEBRIS
- IF YOU PAID A PRIVATE CONTRACTOR, THEY MUST GRIND OR REMOVE YOUR DEBRIS
- THERE IS NO PUBLIC DEBRIS DUMP SITE.. THESE SITES ARE FOR CONTRACTED DUMPING ONLY!!! **DO NOT DUMP AT DEBRIS SITES!**
- PICK UP IS FOR THE ENTIRE COUNTY, NOT JUST THE CITIES
- BLDG. MATERIALS HAVE TO GO TO A LANDFILL (CLOSEST ONES ARE LOWNDES OR ATKINSON COUNTY)
- HOUSEHOLD TRASH, SMALL APPLIANCES & MATTRESSES CAN BE TAKEN TO THE TRASH CENTER ON COUNTY FARM ROAD (COSTS APPLY)
- IF YOU BURN YOUR DEBRIS, PLEASE DO SO SAFELY
- CITY OF NASHVILLE HAS A NO BURN RIGHT NOW
